Labor Studies students learn about the history of the labor movement and current workplace issues. Students are also introduced to federal and state regulations, union contracts, labor negotiations and conciliation as well as arbitration and grievance procedures.

Legal Court Interpretation 510-986-6988

The **Legal Court Interpretation** program prepares students for a career in Spanish interpretation in court and various legal environments. Courses include sight translation, simultaneous interpretation and preparation for the California Court Interpreter Exam.

Machine Technology 510-464-3444

Machinists design and produce precision parts: from nuts and bolts to complex, high-tech components. Laney's hands-on **Machine Technology** program prepares students for various high-skill jobs including constructional machining, maintenance and repair as well as computer-numerical-control (CNC) design and manufacturing.

The **Media Communications** department offers programs and courses in broadcast media, video production and post-production as well as audio/video technology.

Biomedical Engineering Technology 510-464-3246

The **Biomedical Engineering Technology** program prepares students for jobs in biomedical device production and operation. Students learn fundamentals in medical device technology, product development, rapid prototyping and cleanroom protocols.

Students learn film and digital photography techniques, studio photography, lighting and location shooting from experienced professionals at Laney's **Photography** department. Preparation for employment in photography profession is emphasized.

Industrial Maintenance 510-464-3444

The **Industrial Maintenance** multi-disciplinary program prepares students for work in a wide range of industries. Building on precision capability of the machinist trade, the certificate program provides hydraulics, pneumatics, electrical and welding skills that are critical for success. Bay Area employers are partnering with Laney in course development and job placement.

The **Welding** program offers instruction in manual skills and preparation for certification in welding technology. Courses cover beginning to advanced skills in all key welding technologies as well as layout and blueprint reading.

Laney's **Wood Technology** students have access to one of the best-equipped shops in Northern California. Classes include design and construction, computer-aided design and manufacture (CAD-CAM), traditional Japanese hand tools and joinery as well as cabinet-making and studio furniture-making.

Certificates & Degrees

Academic Transfer

Associate Degree

Candidates for the Associate Degree must complete at least 60 degree applicable units, which include required courses in a major, General Education and electives. Students who wish to earn associate degrees and/or transfer to four-year colleges should work with Laney counselors regarding course completion requirements and university transfer prerequisites.


