- 2. Complete at least 30 of those units from the GE courses listed below, including all of Area A and Area B4 (Math) with grades of "C-" or better. NOTE: For some campuses, you may not complete Areas A and B4 during your last semester before enrollment.
- 3. No more than 70 semester/105 quarter units are transferable to the CSU system.

**CERTIFICATION:** Merritt College can provide full or partial certification ONE TIME ONLY. Request certification along with transcripts during the final term before transfer.
