**Stipend amounts**

Set of SLOs and Assessment Plan for a course: \$50

Program/Degree Outcomes and Assessment Plan: \$200 (must be shared between at least two participants)

Simple assessment tool: \$50

Complex assessment tool: \$100

Basic skills assessment tool that could be used across the curriculum (for example, a basic skills reading rubric): \$200 (must be shared between at least two participants)

Assessment tool for a General Education outcome: \$250 shared between at least 3 participants in different departments

Example: arts/humanities assessment tool, social sciences assessment tool, computer sciences assessment tool, etc. The assessment tool must correspond to the appropriate GE outcome.
