Heather Sisneros said that at Solano College, each department has one person with release time (the equivalent of 1 or 2 courses) to work on SLOs and assessment and making sure that department members get it done.

Possibly: Ask for release time and/or stipends for one year

The amount of release time/stipend should depend on how many classes/teachers in the department.

Responsibilities should include making sure that all course SLOs are complete, completing program outcomes, creating assessment tools, coordinating and planning the assessment of

outcomes in the department, recording and reporting on assessment activities, planning improvements based on results. (Making sure that faculty actually perform assessments.) Possibly – only pay them if they actually do the work?
