




HEALTH CARE WORKERS FIGHTING PANDEMIC WORRY FOR THEIR OWN MENTAL HEALTH



- Technology is increasingly employed



- Innovation emergency protocols




Preparedness




Bio & Health Science Job Outlook




Hard Skills to Prioritize

- Written & verbal communication skills






Soft Skills to Prioritize




1: Be resilient and keep searching




