BACKGROUND / SUMMARY

It is being recommended to College Council that a standing calendar be set and adopted for all Laney College shared governance committees. The standing calendar would roll over from year to year. For example, the College Council meetings would be set for the 3^{rd} Wednesday of every month, held from $2:00 - 4:00 \,\text{pm}$, and that would remain the same year after year.

The purpose of the recommendation is to allow for a certain level of consistency in campus governance scheduling. The hope is this will also assist in securing participation in Laney College participatory governance such that committees are staffed in time for the first meeting of the academic year.

In the event that a shared governance committee needs to change their standing meeting time, the request would be submitted to College Council for recommendation to the College President. The new schedule would then be updated in the Participatory Governance Operations Manual (PGOM).

Calling special meetings for strategic reasons would be allowed, but should be communicated to the College community in accordance with the Brown Act.

HOW DOES THIS RECOMMENDATION HELP THE COLLEGE ACHIEVE ITS STRATEGIC GOALS?

Adopting a standing shared governance calendar would allow for a certain level of consistency in campus governance scheduling. The hope is this will also assist in securing participation in Laney College participatory governance such that committees are staffed in time for the first meeting of the academic year.

By having a set schedule, students, staff and faculty will all be able to 1) plan their schedules to allow them to participate in committees of their choice, and 2) will assist the senate presidents and college president (who make the appointments to shared governance committees) to make their appointments to the committees as soon as schedules are set.

Adopting this standing calendar will also allow for 1) constituents to be intentful in planning around their participatory governance activities, and 2) for student and faculty appointments to be made earlier to help ensure fully staffed committee meetings at the beginning of the term. By making this change, the College community is exhibiting how it can identify a barrier to effectiveness and efficiency, and make recommendations for change for continuous improvement.

This change would address the following Goals:

PLAN FOR EVALUATION

All shared governance bodies conduct annual evaluations of their effectiveness. If there is a concern with this new way of operating, the issues can be raised through that avenue. Also, the College President's Office shall include a question to the effectiveness of this move in its assessment survey of the institution's overall shared governance structure and operations.

The Learning Assessment Committee (LAC) has established a new process for assessing Institutional Learning Outcomes (ILOs). This was piloted last year using ILO #4, and though the need to respond to COVID-19 has slowed us down, we are moving forward with ongoing assessment of all ILOs this year. ILO assessment can be done two ways: (1) the short, simple surveys that may or may not involve data entry in currlQunet Meta, and (2) the more involved, intense version using established common rubrics, which requires data entry in Meta on multiple levels.

HOW DOES THIS RECOMMENDATION HELP THE COLLEGE ACHIEVE ITS STRATEGIC GOALS?

Assessment of institutional level learning outcomes (detailed wording of ILOs included in attached documents) furthers achievement of strategic goals 1-4, by the very nature of assessment and the specific nature of each ILO. Assessment is the process by which we achieve continuous quality improvement in all aspects of college work. ILOs cover communication, critical thinking & problem solving, technical skills, global awareness/ethics/civic responsibility, and personal/professional development.

PLAN FOR EVALUATION

We will continue evaluating the work on ILOs on upcoming professional development days, and the LAC will continue to evaluate the processes on a yearly basis. Factors considered will include: how much and quality of data collected, did the process lead to usable action plans, and (upon additional rounds of assessment) does our routine reflection indicate progress. This process was created for long-term success, and is likely to take years to fully show progress for all ILOs.
