- **GOAL #3 –** Develop a community agreement for how we communicate and engage with each other as committee members, ensuring that all input is welcomed and valued. Apply a Diversity Equity & Inclusion (DEI) lens to committee work, membership and decisions.
- **GOAL #4 –** Institute time for monthly updates and feedback from the college’s shared governance bodies, as well as for deep dives into matters that require more in-depth discussions.
- **GOAL #5 –** Improve Council members’ reporting out about Council matters to their constituencies, and reporting back to the Council about their constituencies needs/feedback/input.
