Historical Background

Each of the Peralta Community College District colleges is given an allocation of Measure E funds annually. For the 2022-2023 academic year, the allocation for Laney College is \$2,802,952.55

In previous fiscal years, the Peralta District Finance & Administration Office had the colleges identify a plan for assigning use, first of part-time instructional and part-time non-instructional faculty, (through Fund 1351) directly to Fund 12, referred to as Measure B (the Parcel Tax name on the voter ballot). 2020 was the first year of the renewal of the Parcel Tax now known as Measure E, effective 2020- 2028. Funds are now placed in the specially designated Fund 8.
