Canvas News

Significant progress was made over the summer in regards to the transition to Canvas. Here is a summary of the recent developments:

- > There has been a change in the Moodle-Canvas transition timeline. Because we can no longer support our current version of Moodle, we will complete the transition to Canvas by **Fall 2018**.
- > The Canvas website can be found at **learn.peralta.edu**. The website will not change each semester as it did for Moodle.
- Peralta has subscribed to 24/7 phone support for Canvas. The phone number for Laney Canvas support is (844) 600-4955.
