Consultants' comments:

- 1. *"Celebrate our diversity and build unity."* This item belongs at the Vision level and should pervade all goals and initiatives.
- "Sustainability and education about sustainability" This item should be embedded within other goals as sustainability now pervades numerous instructional programs. Regarding facilities, this should be discussed and highlighted in the FMP.
- 3. *"Provide appropriate up-to-date, user-friendly, technology resources."* We recommend embedding this within several other goals rather than having it stand alone.
