

You must submit a Laney application through CCCApply if you are a new or returning student.

New Student:

You are applying to College for the first time.

Returning Student:

You were previously enrolled at a Peralta College, but have not enrolled in a class in the last two main semesters.

iEnroll@Laney Concurrent Enrollment: Adult High School Students



 Talk to your adult high school guidance counselor to choose a course that will help you reach your educational and professional goals





- Go to https://laney.edu/enroll/ and select the Special Admit Student tile
- Click apply to Laney College to create an account (log into your CCCApply Account if you already have one)
- Click the Start New Application button to complete and submit a new Laney application for the semester you intend to enroll
 - Make sure you indicate in the application that you're currently in adult high school
- You will immediately receive a confirmation number that starts with the number 2 (Save the confirmation number)
- You will be emailed your 8-digit Peralta Student ID number, password and student email information within 24-48 hours after application submission
- A returning student will receive a Welcome Back email and their already established 8-digit Peralta Student ID number

Submit Your Special Enrollment Form

- Email approved form and photo ID to Laneyadmissions@peralta.edu or submit to the Laney A&R Office (Buiding A-109)
 - English, Math, Chemistry and other pre-requisites will need to be cleared by a Laney counselor before submission
 - You can schedule a counseling appointment by calling (510) 464-3152, through Zoom by visiting https://Laney.edu/counseling/ or you can see a counselor in person on the 3rd floor of the Tower Building
 - * Forms submitted by email will have classes added within 2-3 buisiness days

Tuition and Fee

- Special part-time adult high school students are exempt from paying the California Community College enrollment fees and all other fees.
 Adult high school students enrolled in more than 15.0 units are required to pay enrollment and all other mandatory fees (see the current Peralta Colleges class schedule for current health, campus use and transportation fees)
 - Units earned will be granted as college credit. It is the adult high school's prerogative to grant adult high school credit for courses taken in the Peralta Colleges. The Office of Admissions and Records will send a transcript to the high school upon request
