During this time, using your smart phone and/or technology will be your best friend. For example, if you have a Gmail account, you can use your Google docs to complete assignments. See some other ideas below:

- 1. Check to see if your books are at the Oakland Public library.
- 2. Ask a classmate to take pictures of the assignments you have to complete and/or read.
- 3. Ask the instructor if he/she has the book on reserved in the Laney library.
- 4. Check to see if there are any free/affordable downloads online.
- 5. If you are connected with former classmates/friends who took your class, ask if you can borrow their book(s).
- 6. If you are connected with a former classmate/friend in your class, form a study group so you will be able to have access help with assignments.
- 7. Ask someone to purchase your books and you can pay them back in installments.
- 8. Ask the instructor if he/she has a spare copy of the book to scan and email to yourself or copy.
- 9. Contact other Peralta Libraries to see if they may carry the book.
