9. LAKE MERRITT BART- East Bay Asian Local Development

Introduction to project concept.

RFP for BART development. 9 principles developed with extensive community engagement.

-complements commercial area of Chinatown, reduces gentrification, increases community control over site.

Partnership with Strada as private market rate investment portion of project. Public investment in active streets, not private.

Overview of Multibuilding plan. Mixed between affordable and senor housing, and commercial space. (44% affordable housing).

High quality public open space.

2019- Meeting with stakeholders

2020, secure entitlements and construction

2021, begin phase 1 of construction

10. ORTON DEVELOPMENT- KAISER CENTER UPDATE

- -Arena being developed as co-working space,
- -Theater being restored as 1500 seat theater. 600-800 seats on the theater floor.
- -3rd floor ballroom and rehearsal room
- -Add porch terrace/deck to lakeside of building with restaurant
- -Adding entrance on 10th St

Creating courtyard and walkway between Kaiser and OMCA to connect Laney more to Lake.

20% dedicated to arts and nonprofit groups

- -Labor opportunities for construction and theater production
- -Construction beginning 2019-2020, hope to open within 2 years
- -Possibilities for cross partnerships between theater arts, dance, and Laney culinary
