College Committee Meetings

College President Gilkerson convened a meeting of all college committee chairs on September 26 to review the Participatory Governance Manual. Plans are being made to update the manual.

CTE Advisory Committee

The committee had its election during the week of September 17.

College Council

The council met on September 19. Changes to the Enrollment Management Committee were partially approved (name change to Strategic EMC approved, charge change approved, composition sent back to the committee). Changes to the composition of the Foundation Skills Committee were also sent back to the committee. Installation of a sundial sculpture was recommended by the Facilities Planning Committee and approved by the College Council.

Faculty Senate Constitution Subcommittee
