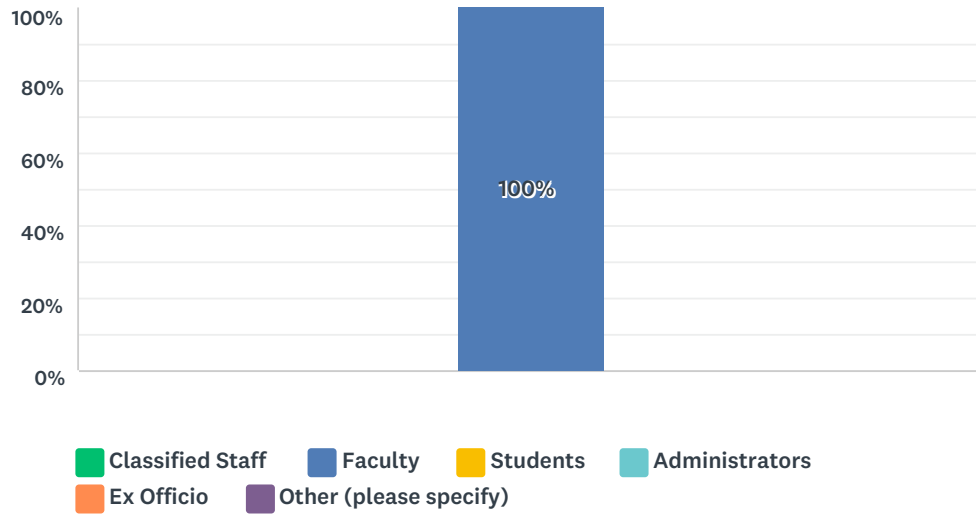


Q1 What constituency do you represent on the committee?

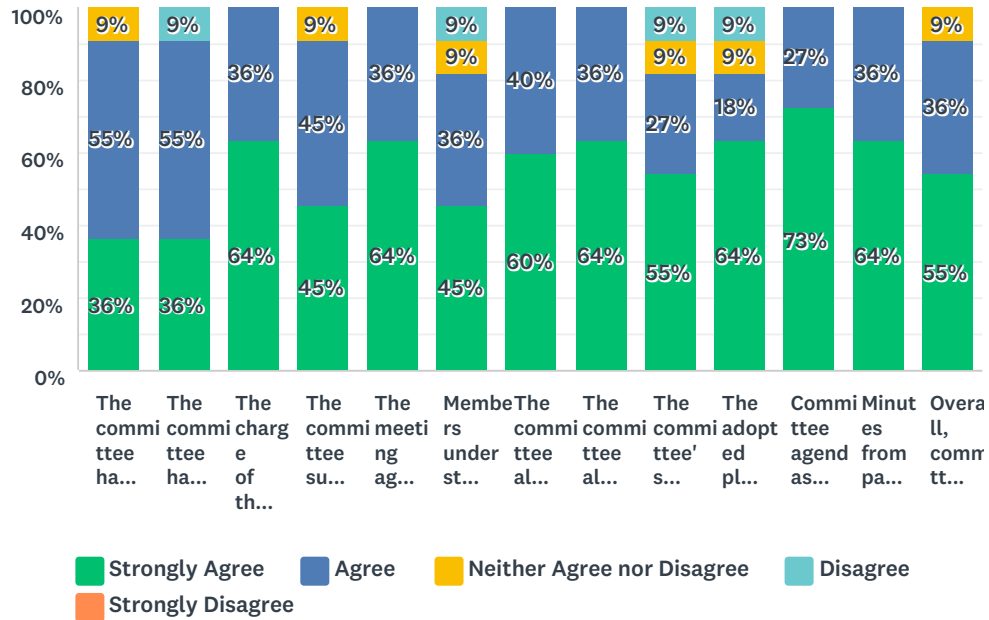
