Resolution on Joining the California Virtual Campus—Online Education Initiative (CVC-OEI) Consortium

Whereas, The California Virtual Campus—Online Education Initiative's (CVC-OEI) goal of ensuring more students complete their educational goals by increasing access to and success in high-quality online courses align with the mission and vision of Laney College;

Whereas, The student support services funded by the CVC-OEI such as online tutoring, counseling, and proctoring align with Goals #2.2a and 2.2b of the Laney College Distance Education Plan to make improvements to existing student support and learning services for online students in order to close opportunity gaps and promote equity;

Whereas, the Laney College Distance Education Committee voted to recommend that the college apply for the CVC-OEI Consortium in Spring 2019.

Be it resolved, that the Faculty Senate fully supports Laney College's application to join the CVC-OEI Consortium Cohort in 2020 as well as the adoption of both the OEI Course Design Rubric¹ and Peralta Online Equity Rubric.²
