Steps to be Prepared:

- 1. Bring student and parent's Social Security #'s (and Alien Registration #'s if you are not a U.S. Citizen).**
 - * If you don't have either, you may be eligible for the CA DREAM Act App and scholarships.
- 2. Bring your family's most recent 2018 Federal tax forms like 1040, W-2, bank statements, etc. You will not have to reveal this information to anyone, but you will need to complete the forms.**
 - * If your family does not file taxes and / or receives public assistance please bring those statements.
