Once the college receives the FAFSA results, to determine CCPG-C eligibility, the financial aid office subtracts the student’s Expected Family Contribution (EFC) from their cost of attendance. If what remains (‘financial need’) is \$1,104 or greater, the student is given a fee waiver. Waivers are posted onto the registration computer system automatically once results are received from the federal processor. **The waiver will automatically appear on the system if you are eligible.** When you register using the Campus Solutions system you will not be assessed the \$46/unit enrollment fees.
