

SLOs for the Japanese Program

At present, the program has three courses: Japanese 1A, 50A and 50B.

1A is focused on grammar, structures and writings. In the completion of the course students will be able to 1) read and write hiragana, katakana and about 40 kanji characters, 2) recognize and use basic Japanese grammar and common expressions, 3) have simple conversations with Japanese friends, and 4) Respond appropriately to questions in basic Japanese.

50A and 50B are focused on conversation and culture. In the social and business contexts, in the completion of those two courses students will be able to 1) pronounce Japanese words correctly, 2) have basic conversations with Japanese people, 3) recognize and use basic Japanese grammar and common expressions, 4) respond appropriately to questions in Japanese, and 5) acquire basic knowledge in Japanese culture.
