### **Number of Years Working at Laney College**

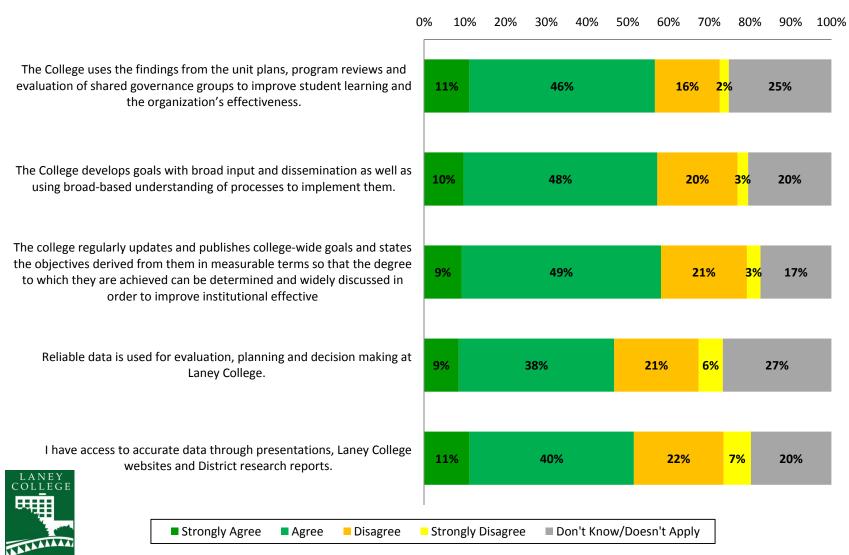




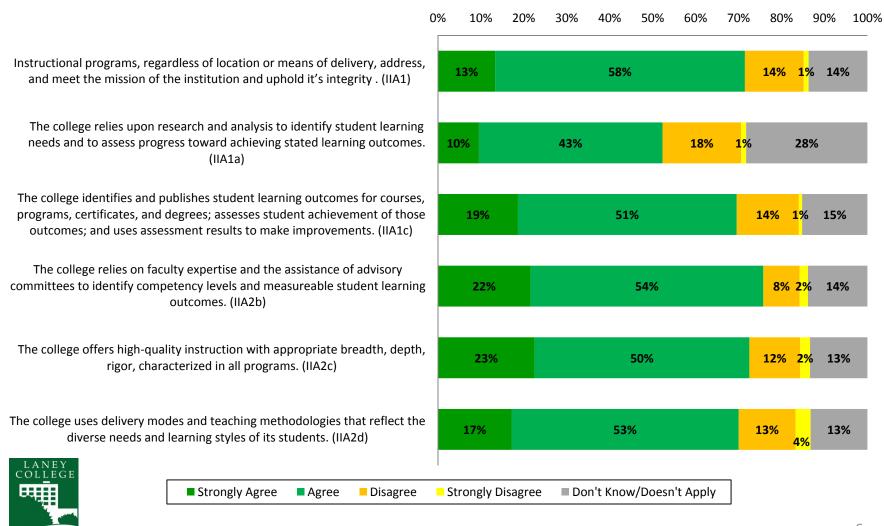

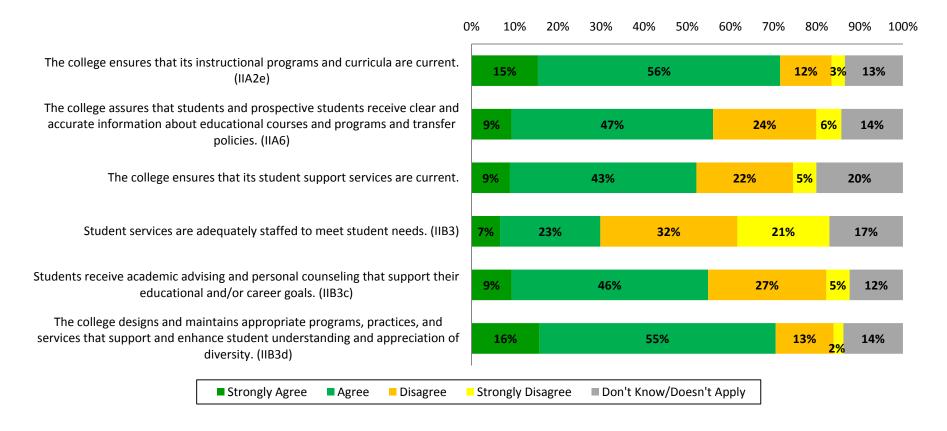

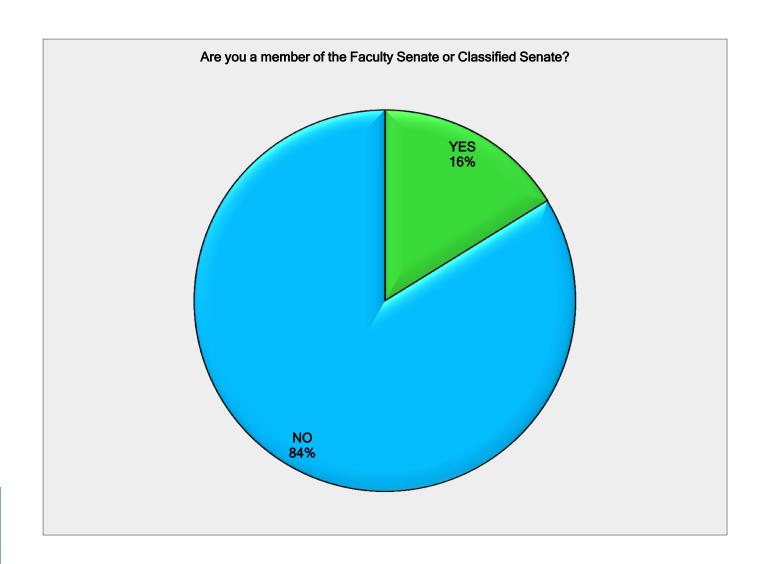

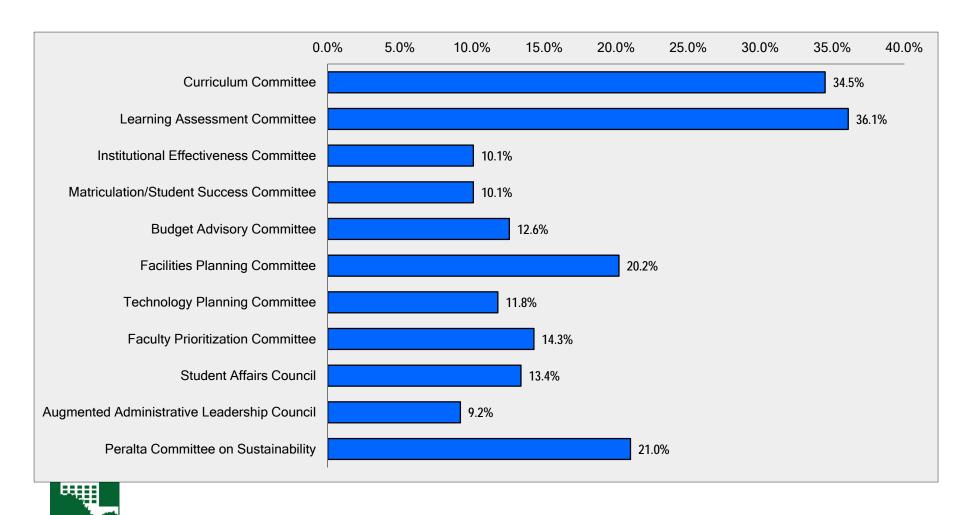

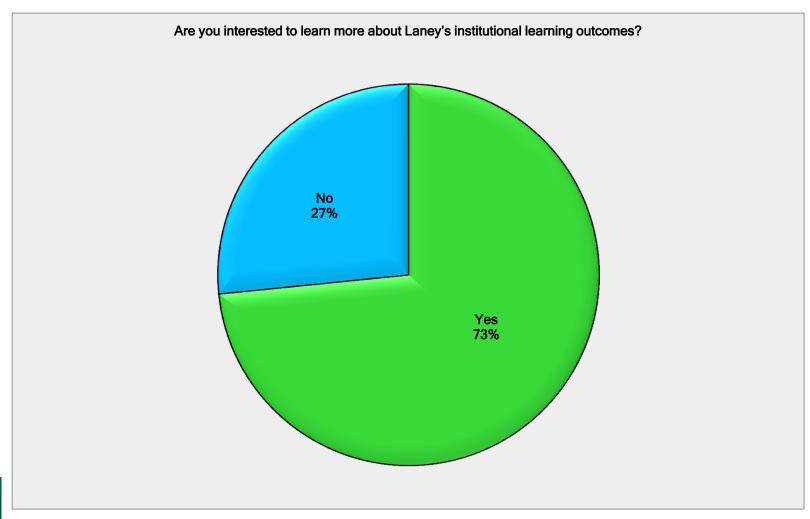

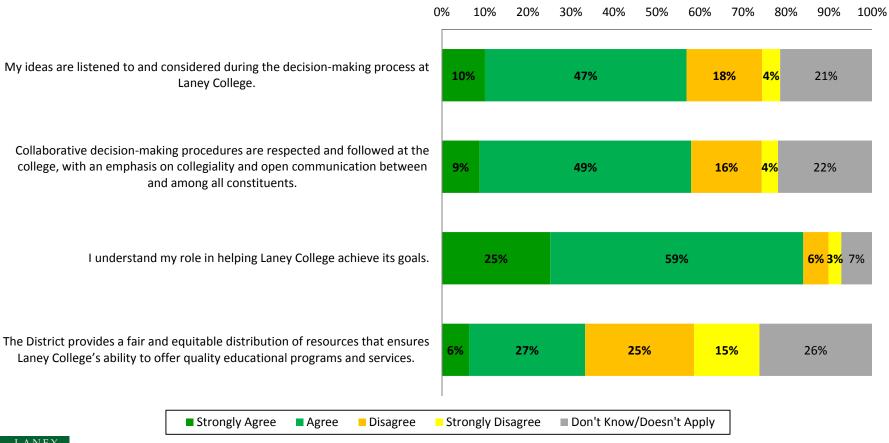

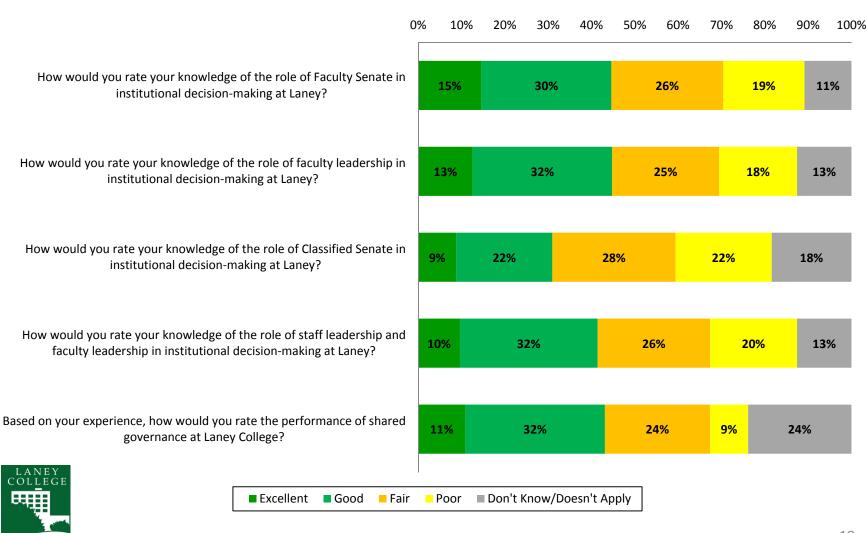

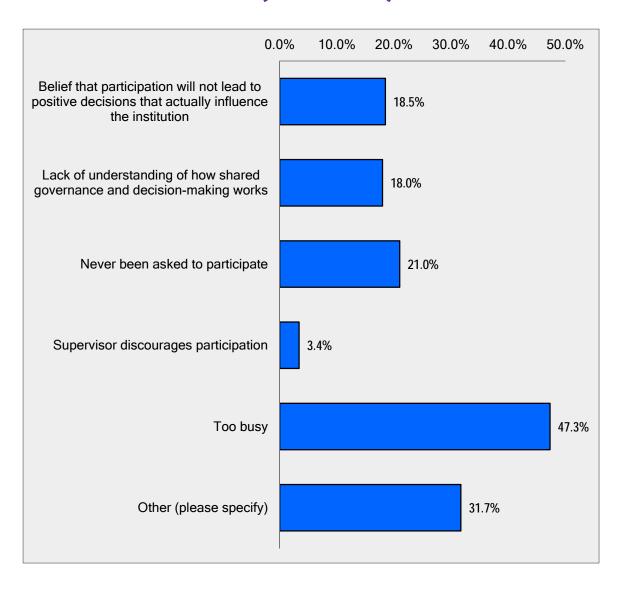

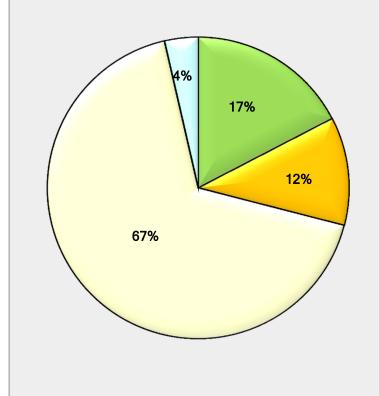
