


Laney Women's Basketball Celebrates Sophomore Night & Historic Season



Laney College Women's Basketball closed out its final home game on February 17 with a Sophomore Night celebration honoring nine student-athletes who will transfer to continue their academic and athletic careers. The event included a campus pre-game tailgate hosted by ASLC and the President's Office, bringing together students, employees, and fans in support of the team.

The Eagles completed an exceptional regular season, finishing Bay Valley Conference play undefeated (13-0) and posting an overall 22-3 record, highlighted by an 18-game winning streak. The team capped the evening with a decisive 111-63 victory over Napa Valley College.

Sophomore Night underscored the mission of Laney Athletics—academic achievement, competitive excellence, and successful transfer outcomes—while celebrating one of the strongest seasons in recent program history.




Laney College Celebrates Lunar New Year
