The meeting was called by Trent Tornabene for the purpose of selecting Flooring samples, Locker laminates, and finalizing the selection of exterior building metal finishes being considered by the Athletic Director and staff.

FLOORING:

After much discussion and sampling of colors it was decided to use the attached Mondo Flooring as shown on the representative drawings. Angel Alvarez independently reviewed the mark up and became satisfied that Doug had the correct designations for the flooring.

Flooring for the IT Room not yet selected because of Static electricity characteristics. Doug will select best match.

Counter top color for the Training Room was selected as Corian Green Tea Break Room and Conference Corian "Medea"

CONCRETE:

The Interior concrete bench will be Grey
The exterior concrete bench will be Pewter
The Precast concrete Threads will be Charcoal Black, samples to be seen tomorrow.

LOCKERS:

Doors Appleply Clear light wood grain with Manitoba Maple #7911-60 laminate finish throughout.



EXTERIOR METAL FINISHES:

Powder coated White and if the Green color offered matches the Laney College green as displayed in the Baseball Field, Doug has been asked to use it for the Second Floor guard rails at the center of the Field House.
