- Fulfill or expand an instructional program that is not fully funded by the District Budget Allocation Model (BAM)
- Fulfill or expand a student support program that is not fully funded by the District BAM

Purpose/Rationale of the Project:

The first function of the grant writer is to expand support services to at risk disabled students. The grant writer will seek funds specifically for students who have documented disabilities who are striving to reach their goals of academic success, transfer to four year universities and / or transition into jobs and careers.

The grant writer will identify resources and opportunities that can be shared with CalWORKs, EOPS and other categorical programs which serve disadvantaged Laney students.

The second function of the grant writer is to individually assist students in accessing and applying for scholarships.

Over the years DSPS has lost academic classes and support services. Students continue struggling toward their goals. With funds gained from community resources these vulnerable and valiant students will have improved access to academic success, transfers to four year universities and/or transition into fruitful jobs and careers

Number of Students Expected to be Served:
