

Assignments are graded in the following manner:

**All assignments have the potential to earn 10 points
(10=A; 9=A-; 8=B+; 7=B; 6=B-; 5=C+; 4=C; 3=C-; 2=D+; 1=D)**

For these reasons an assignment will be rejected without a grade:

Bad borders on the print(s)

No (or inadequate) documentation

Negative not included*

Negative printed backwards

Assignment goal not achieved

If an assignment is rejected you must resubmit it after correcting the problem.

*** Not including a negative is acceptable if there is another image on the negative strip that will be used on a subsequent assignment. Include a note stating that you are currently using the negative strip.**

Points are lost for the following reasons and to the degree shown:

Improper exposure and/or development of the film	1-6 pts.
Improper exposure and/or development of the print	1-8 pts
Improper contrast of the print	1-3 pts
Lack of filter use	4-6 pts.
Lack of (or poor) burning & dodging	2-5 pts.
Weak composition	1-4 pts
Not all images in a series submitted	8 pts.
Lack of technical consistency among the images in a series	2-4 pts.
Negatives not in sleeves	2-4 pts.

Dust spots on prints	1-3 pts.
Fingerprints on negatives / prints	1-3 pts
Prints embossed from writing on the back	3 pts.
Chemical stains, scratches, tong marks on prints	2-4 pts.

Points will be deleted for any given flaw based on the degree of error
