



Cross- Registration to Mills College

The Cross Registration Program (SB 1914) allows undergraduate students who meet certain eligibility criteria and are enrolled at any California Community College, the California State University, or the University of California to enroll, without formal admission in any other systems.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Students must have completed 12 semester units with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 at the time of application.
2. Student must be enrolled in at least 9 semester units at Laney College.
3. International Students must be enrolled in 12 units at Laney College.
4. Offered fall and spring semesters only.
5. Majority of units must be enrolled at Laney College during the current semester the student seeks to cross-enroll at a four-year institution.
6. Limit is one undergraduate course per semester at Mills College.
7. Completion of any necessary prerequisite courses for the planned University course.
8. **Enrollment is permitted in course after all registered and added Mills students—discretion is up to instructor(s).**
9. May not enroll in a course that is articulated to Laney College.
10. Students cannot enroll in Extension, summer session, graduate level and any other courses not supported by the state.
11. There will be no additional tuition or fees charged by the host institution, with the exception of studio or lab fees.
12. **Students with a bachelor's degree or higher may not participate in the cross-enrollment program.**
