3. You must have a GPA of 2.7 or higher and are required submit a copy of your transcript indicating your Grade Point Average (GPA). We do accept unofficial school transcripts.

To Apply for a Single Parent Scholarship, you must to the do the following:

1. Applications will be accepted by e-mail only to scholarships@druglawsuitsource.com
2. In the e-mail subject line, type Single Parent Scholarship Application
3. In your e-mail, you must:
 - Provide your full legal name, current address, a phone number, and e-mail so we can reach you if you are awarded the scholarship.
 - Provide us with the first name only and age of each child that you are helping to raise
 - Type a 300-600 word essay explaining your career goals, the challenges that being a single parent presents in reaching those goals, and how you intend to deal with those challenges.
 - Attach an official or unofficial school transcript for your current school.
4. By submitting an application, you are verifying that you are a single parent enrolled in school and give us permission to put your name on our website if you are awarded a scholarship. You are also giving Drug Lawsuit Source the permission to review your academic record. We will not share your personal information with anyone and will destroy your transcript and personal essay after the scholarships are awarded to protect your privacy.

The deadline to apply is November 1, 2015.

The scholarships will be awarded on November 15, 2015. Winners will be notified by e-mail.
