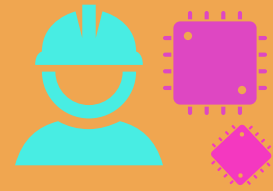

Elevator Repairs

Theater & Student Services Center:

The contract was approved at the September 9th board meeting. Kone Elevator will be starting the job once the contract documents are complete. There is an 8-10 week lead time for parts, the on-site work will likely begin in mid-December and both elevators should be back in service in time for spring semester.



Fire Watch

The majority of the fire alarm panel repairs have been completed. Three buildings needed new alarm panels. After having the plans review by Oakland Fire , the contractor began the installation and should be done in the next two weeks. We are coordinating with Oakland fire perform the re-inspection which will finally allow us to be removed from fire watch.



Paving Around Campus

A project is in the works to repair the paving around the perimeter of campus. In the meantime the pot holes behind the F & G buildings have been patched.



Broken Windows: The window project was approved by the Board and contracts have been completed. A pre-construction meeting will take place on October 11th and then the project will begin. Due to lead times on some of the glass, we anticipate the project to be complete by the beginning of the spring semester.
