

Important Action Needed for your Zoom account: Since our Zoom accounts are provided by the State, they have sent this message:Effective 06/30/2021 all TechConnect Zoom recordings with a creation date prior to August 15, 2020 will be deleted from user accounts. Once these files are deleted, they will be held in Zoom trash and available for retrieval by you for 30 days after the date of deletion. However, after 30 days in Zoom trash, any recordings held there will be permanently removed and no longer be accessible. Start now to proactively manage your Zoom recordings.
